At LSU Vet Med, our Veterinary Teaching Hospital is home to the most board-certified specialists under one roof in Louisiana and is open 24/7, 365 days a year to serve animals across the region and beyond. Small animal rotating interns work closely with LSU Vet Med faculty, residents, specialty interns, veterinary technicians, and students in a highly collaborative environment focused on delivering exceptional patient care.

GAIN KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE. You will rotate through Emergency & Critical Care, Internal Medicine, Cardiology, Surgery, and Anesthesia with 10 weeks allotted for elective rotations. Orientation lectures and wet labs are also provided. Rotations include rounds, case presentations, journal club, continuing education, and more. Our Emergency Service sees an average of 15 cases each day, and more than 21,000 cases come through the hospital each year.
